Anuchit in the faculty of Pharmacy at PSU picked me up at the airport and hosted the visit.
He also nicely explained the difference of taste of Thai food in the southern part of Thai.
I visited Prince of Songklar University at the faculty of pharmaceutical science, and had
business talk with Dean and administrative staffs. International cooperation program in this
department was certainly excellent. I also had chance to look through various laboratories in
